

These are the readings appointed for today

THE FIRST READING Ephesians 2: 19 to 22

You are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling-place for God.

THE GOSPEL READING John 20: 24 to 29

Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So, the other disciples told him, 'We have seen the Lord.' But he said to them, 'Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe.' A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe.' Thomas answered him, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him, 'Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe.

RENEWED HOPE VACANCIES

Renewed Hope is in desperate need of volunteers on weekdays and Saturdays. They haven't been running Winter Night Shelter for 2 years, but the Drop-In is busier than ever.

Drop-In is open 11am to 3pm weekdays and 12-1.30pm Saturdays and bank holidays. Volunteers should give 15-20 mins either side of the shift. Training is provided and you are supported by an experienced Drop-In leader at all times. During the week a member of staff is around.

Roles:

Drop-In Leader – If you are trained as a Winter Night Shelter supervisor, please consider yourself for this role. It is much simpler, but with many similarities

General Drop-In assistants – helping with tasks such as making teas and coffees, serving meals, chatting with guests

Kitchen Assistants – helping in the kitchen with the supervisor preparing a two-course lunch for the day

Kitchen Supervisor - prepare and cook on site for up to 20 people using items donated to RH or your own.

Food Hygiene Level 2 is required for kitchen volunteers in particular. Please let them know if you need them to arrange that for you free of charge, or an optional donation of £15 towards the cost.
